In-store Coupon Policy

As a customer friendly retailer, we encourage the use of coupons by our guests in our retail store in accordance with the following guidelines.

- Coupons should be presented to the cashier at the beginning of the transaction.
- Coupons should not be mutilated or torn.
- Coupons with a face value of 50¢ or less may be doubled.
- Coupons will never exceed the purchase price of merchandise.
- Coupons for free merchandise will not be doubled.
- Expired coupons will not be redeemed.
- Product must be purchased for the specific size and product stated on the coupon.
- Coupons from Scott's ads will be honored as stated on the coupon.
- Coupons from other retailers' ads will not be honored.
- Internet/Print-At-Home Coupons. *At this time we are accepting internet coupons. There is an increasing frequency of fraudulent internet coupons, and we ask you to help us combat this problem. There are several things to watch for when printing coupons from the internet. Fraudulent coupons typically:
 - are for a high dollar amount or free product
 - come from sites that sell coupons or sell a coupon clipping service
 - are frequently attached to emails

*Since there are currently no valid internet print-at-home coupons for free products, we will therefore not accept internet coupons for free items.

Double coupon example: If a customer presents a coupon for 50¢ off, we will double the coupon, making it \$1 off. If a customer presents a coupon for 51¢ off (or greater), the coupon is worth its face value of 51¢ (or greater) and will not be doubled.
